- 4. Treasurer's Report Chair Clevenger- \$56,471.98. Received a \$39,836.63 check from Bonner Co. for taxes and a Denny Bullock \$100 donation. Expenses anticipated check to Raycom, \$6,705. Idaho state police \$20 background check, CCBFD sent a check to pay engine repair \$2,821.30 that intends to be reimbursed to the repair company. and that will be passed, received a check from them. - 5. Pay Raycom Invoice \$6,705 Chair Clevenger moved to pay Raycom for radios. Comm. McKinstry seconded. Passed 2-0
- 6. Fire Chief's report Chief Tom Renzi
- a. Training update:
 - --260 hours for our training in 2021 included 22 classes, averaging about 6 per session.
- b. Pasco SCBA's ready to pick up—Planning go down January 25th and will need a check in case of some unanticipated expenses.
- 7. Building Location & Plans (Comm. McKinstry & Asst. Chief Tewel) Comm. McKinstry and Dave Tewel
 - a. Contacts with IDLPR—Senator Jim Woodward and Susan Buxton, IDPR Director to have a zoom meeting, yet to be scheduled.
 - b. Pinto Point Community Lot Update- Dave Tewel reported to Comm. McKinstry they have been looking at sewer district updates, working to locating a civil engineer, working with pandhandle health. New drainfield on the opposite side of the lot would not conflict with a structure. The Health district, indicated EPLFD could tie in or create its own septic system, might be cheaper and easier to manage, also, a fresh water well one hundred feet away from the drainfield, which was achievable. Power will need to be run to the area which could be a shared cost by Pinto Point. Also, Tewel clarified that a cleared area next to the proposed community lot known as an IDL slash burn area, is part of the Pinto Point land, not IDL, and could possibly be an opportunity for a fire station area and helicopter zone.
 - c. Dave Tewel is also talking with Dan Brown, about IDL potential property.
